Day 1 – Thursday, April 16: Arrival in Santiago & City Highlights

Upon arrival at Santiago International Airport, you will be met by your private driver and transferred to your hotel in the city (approximately 40 minutes away). Look for a sign with your name in the arrivals area.

In the afternoon, set out on a privately guided half-day tour of Santiago. Begin at Santa Lucía Hill, where the city was founded, and take in panoramic views of the capital. Continue to Plaza de Armas, the historical center surrounded by colonial-era architecture, and then to La Moneda Palace, the seat of the Chilean government.

You'll also visit Plaza de la Constitución and explore the Mercado Central, a lively and traditional food market full of local flavors. Your final stop will be Barrio Lastarria, a bohemian neighborhood known for its charming streets, art galleries, and inviting cafés.

In the evening, enjoy a welcome dinner with wine tasting at La Bodeguita, a cozy local restaurant offering a flavorful introduction to Chilean cuisine and hospitality.

Day 2 - Friday, April 17: Santiago Wine Adventure

After breakfast, embark on a private full-day wine excursion to the renowned Concha y Toro and Almaviva Vineyards.

Sample five glasses of ultra-premium wine paired with a premium cheese board.

Continue to Almaviva Vineyard for a half-day tasting, featuring the celebrated Almaviva 2020 and EPU 2019 wines. Private transfers and English-speaking guide assistance are included throughout the day.

Explore La Boca, a lively district known for its colorful houses and tango dancers on the streets, and then continue to Recoleta, one of the city's most elegant neighborhoods, known for its stunning European-style architecture and famous cemetery.

Conclude the day with The Argentine Experience, a culinary adventure featuring a 16-course tasting menu of Argentina's essential dishes, each paired with fine wines. Learn about the country's food traditions while savoring each dish in a festive, interactive setting.
